ASSISTED DYING BILL Last weekend we read a Joint Pastoral Letter on The Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill from Cardinal Vincent Nichols together with all the Bishops of England and Wales. Bishop Mark writes "I know many of you will have heard news reports that the Bill brought forward by Kim Leadbeater MP, if accepted by Parliament, may not be implemented for another four years. It is reported that the Department of Health and Social Care believe the proposed legislation is unworkable. The decisive, final vote in the House of Commons is expected to take place on Fri 25th April. We cannot fail to note the significance that this is the Friday of the Easter Octave. It is therefore imperative that we take action to contact your Member of Parliament to support them in opposing this legislation or to ask their MP to change their mind in the light of the obvious flaws and appalling dangers of this legislation. The charity Right to *Life UK* has a simple online mechanism to allow people to contact their MP and it only takes a few moments to submit a message to ask an MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law. It can be accessed here: https:// righttolife.org.uk/asvote. Right to Life is also distributing postcards to parishes for the lay faithful to send to their MPs on this subject.
