LIFE IS HARD ON THE STREET AS TEMPERATURES DROP - SVP APPEAL for your help for both the homeless refugees which are increasing every week and local people who are made homeless at this desperate time. We are working with Hope Church (Crewe) and LATH (Looking After The Homeless) We need clean, ready to wear men's winter coats, fleeces, sweatshirts, T-shirts, tracksuit bottoms, jeans, socks, new underwear and footwear (especially trainers). There is a box for donations in the porch. **Update:** We have 8 refugees living in 5 tents in the centre of Crewe and similar numbers of local men on the street that attend LATH and these numbers are increasing each week. We have had a recent number of successes getting 3 refugees into rooms with YMCA and Cheshire East and 2 local vulnerable men into one person flats with Cheshire East. Thank you again for the generous donations by St Gabriel's and St Anne's congregations as they really make a difference especially in the winter weather.
